ZAGNY BOARD ELECTIONS 2005 to 2008 TERM

In March 2005, the three-year term of the current ZAGNY board will come to a close and a new board will be elected on March 19th, 2005, at the Navroz function. Below is the absentee/mail ballot showing names of the nominees standing for election for various positions. On the day of the election you will have the opportunity to hear from each of the candidates and to vote for them in person. If you are unable to attend the meeting in person, you may use the attached ballots to vote by mail, following the procedures given below:

- 1. Only dues paying adult members of ZAGNY are eligible to vote.
- **2.** Please send your membership dues with the enclosed membership form to Jasmin Kotwal, if you have not already done so.
- 3. Each adult (18 years old) member has one vote, with up to two votes per family membership. (Reminder: Non-Zoroastrian spouses of Zoroastrian members are full voting members and are encouraged to vote).
- 4. <u>IMPORTANT</u>: Please fill out the Absentee/Mail Ballot, seal it in an envelope with the names and address of the voting members written on the outside left corner of the envelope and mail it to Arnavaz Patel, 2077 Center Ave, Apartment 14E, Fort Lee, NJ 07024, and postmarked no later than March 10th, 2005. <u>Unnamed envelopes will be disqualified</u>.

APPEAL FOR HELP FROM MUMBAI, INDIA

An urgent appeal to help Mr. Kersas Batliwala of Mumbai, India has reached the Zoroastrian community within North America. Kersas has been diagnosed with cancer of the lungs which has spread into the spinal cord. He was initially treated in the Parsi General Hospital for a week, where several tests were performed. He lost sensation in both the feet because of compression of one of the vertebras in the spinal cord. He was transferred to Hinduja Hospital, where he underwent a spinal cord surgery to correct the compression of the vertebra in the spinal cord.

Kersas has already incurred astronomical medical bills between the two hospitals. He is expected to stay in the hospital for some time to complete the radiation and physical therapy treatments, which will add substantially to the medical bills. Kersas is the only earning member of the family of five, working in a local bank. With his financial means, he can not afford the astronomical medical bills. 
