ZAGNY CELEBRATES JAMSHEDI NAVROZE 2005

The celebration of Jamshedi Navroze bridges the old year to the New Year with the advent of spring. The resurgence of life takes place during this period with the symbolic victory of the forces of light over darkness.

Legend has it that the Jamshedi Navroze celebration dates back to the times of the legendary King of Persia, Jamshed. It is said that King Jamshed introduced solar calculations into the Persian calendar, and therefore set as the beginning of the year the date the sun enters the constellation of Aries. Also, legend has it that on this day King Jamshed forced the demons to carry him on their shoulders from Mount Demavand to Babylon.

This day came to be known as Navroze or Jamshedi Navroze day.

ZAGNY BOARD ELECTIONS 2005 to 2008 TERM

In March 2005, the three-year term of the current ZAGNY board will come to a close and a new board will be elected on March 19th, 2005, at the Navroz function. On the back page of this newsletter is the absentee/mail ballot showing names of the nominees standing for election for various positions. On the day of the election you will have the opportunity to hear from each of the candidates and to vote for them in person. If you are unable to attend the meeting in person, you may use the attached ballots to vote by mail, following the procedures given below:

1. Only dues paying adult members of ZAGNY are eligible to vote.

2. Please send your membership dues with the enclosed membership form to Jasmin Kotwal, if you have not already done so.

3. Each adult (18 years old) member has one vote, with up to two votes per family membership. (Reminder: Non-Zoroastrian spouses of Zoroastrian members are full voting members and are encouraged to vote).

4. IMPORTANT: Please fill out the Absentee/Mail Ballot, seal it in an envelope with the names and address of the voting members written on the outside left corner of the envelope and mail it to Arnavaz Patel, 2077 Center Ave, Apartment 14E, Fort Lee, NJ 07024, and postmarked no later than March 10th, 2005. Unnamed envelopes will be disqualified.

Note: If you vote by mail and are present at the election, you may revoke your mailed ballot and vote in person.

THE PARZOR FOUNDATION – FOR PRESERVATION OF VULNERABLE HUMAN HERITAGE

The following is an excerpt from the Parzor Foundation brochure which describes the Parzor Project based in Delhi:

"UNESCO acting as a catalyst initiated the Project for the Preservation and Promotion of Parsi Zoroastrian Culture and Heritage in 1999. The activities of the project are multifaceted and include serious research into every aspect of the community. The Parsis are a distinct thread in the tapestry of multi-cultural India. Followers of the Bronze Age prophet Zarathustra of Iran, Zoroastrianism if the world's oldest revealed religion. It has survived with its core beliefs intact; "Humata, Hukata, Huvarashta" Good Thoughts, Good Words, Good Deeds, provide the key to a holistic vision of life. This vision has perhaps helped the Parsis, less that 0.01% of India's population to contribute positively to the making of modern India.

Iranian, Indian, Chinese, and European influences have helped create a hybrid Parsi culture. Loss of cultural traditions is growing phenomenon worldwide, when to this is added a steep demographic decline there is danger of a culture being lost.

There is a need to create awareness about this miniscule minority within the community, country and the world. The UNESCO Parzor Project concerns not only the Zoroastrians but is trying to preserve an ancient thread in the Heritage of Humanity."

The Indicorps Fellowship is an intense, grassroots public service program for people of Indian origin to implement sustainable development projects with community based organizations across India. The Indicorps fellowship demands commitment and determination but offers in return an invaluable personal experience. The structure of the Indicorps fellowship is created to rapidly acclimate fellows to India and to their specific projects.

Fellows participate in a four-week orientation program, share experiences through regular retreats, and are actively supported by Indicorps and partner organizations.

Prospective fellows must be of Indian origin with a university degree or five years equivalent work experience and must be citizens or permanent residents of the United States, Canada, or the United Kingdom.
