Here are some Questions answered by Michel Reid:

Can I register my email address even if I am not a paid ZAGNY member? Yes, anyone can register to get ZAGNY emails and announcements.

If I am receiving ZAGNY's emails, do I still have to register my email address? No, that means you are registered for email notifications and no action needs to be taken on your part.

If one's email address has changed, does one just register the new one on that link at the top of the web page? Or does one update the old email address? Just register the new one. You can only update the old one if you are successfully receiving the email announcements, by clicking on the provided link in one of the emails.

And what if I want to check my email address, whether it is correctly registered or not to receive the announcements. How do I know that? You cannot check to see if your email address is registered correctly. You know it is correct if you're already getting email announcements/notifications from ZAGNY. If you are not getting the emails, then you need to register your email address on the website.

Maybe some people are not even aware that their emails address is not registered or it is the old one and hence are not receiving email notifications.

This is certainly the case. If you are not receiving the emails, you need to register your email address on the online sign-up form by clicking - "Please subscribe" at the top of the page on the website.

How do I access files for viewing by *paid* members only? The only way to access the files (which are stored in the Members Only section of the **Forum** is to (A) register on the forums AND (B) follow the instructions to be elevated to a "Paid Member" to gain access to the Members Only section.


